


*CISPEE'13 Best Poster*

The best poster selection process comprised: (i) an evaluation panel with 3 members (from different area knowledges); and (ii) a ballot process open to all conference participants (excluding all posters authors). The members of the evaluation panel were:

- Prof. António Alberto Crispim, from the Polytechnich of Porto - School of Engineering, as an expert in the scientific - technical domain
- -Dr. Vasco Trigo, from the Autonomous University of Lisbon and Social Communication School from the Lisbon Polytechnic Institute, as an expert in communication, and
- Mr. José Silva, from the Polytechnich of Porto - School of Engineering, as an expert in design. Mr. José Silva works for the design office at ISEP and was the responsible for designing all the image and dissemination materials for CISPEE.

Each specialist evaluated each poster, individually, in terms of its merit (from 1 - lowest to 5 - highest). The score given by each specialist was worth 25% of the final score. The results of the ballot process contributed with the remaining 25%. The most voted poster received 5 points, the second 3 points and the third 1 point. The final results are depicted in the following table, listing the top-3 rank.
